

Recommendations for the 2007 LaSyS workshop

Keywords:

- End at lunchtime !
- More interaction between institutions and disciplines
- Cases: More focus on how to address research questions
- Better basis for case studies. Suggested reading should be given in advance
- Themes for discussion should be less vague.
- Suggestions for further research should be discussed
- Emphasis on retrospective studies
- Interactive session (on the 2nd day) should focus on themes of key presentations rather than on case studies
- A provocative statement may help to focus discussions
- Focus on real examples of interdisciplinarity, rather than 'traditional', disciplinary presentations
- Suggestion for theme: What are the obstacles to interdisciplinarity ?
- Two interactive sessions with different objectives
- Could Danish examples be placed in an international context ?
- Other formats for obtaining interaction and participation, eg. use of short presentations in combination with panels
- The next workshop could be organized jointly with GLP or other networks/projects, in order to get greater international input
